CAMDEN – On Tuesday, which was Earth Day, Camden resident and avid gardener Ernesto Ventura Sr. received a free tree to add to his yard.

“This will fit in nicely with my tomatoes, grapes and other trees,” he said in an interview as he examined the roughly 2-foot piece of greenery.

The tree Ventura received was one of 75 that the Subaru Corporation, through the Arbor Day Foundation, gave away for free during the Camden Cleanup kickoff that took place at Dudley Grange Park, Adam Leiter, a corporate communications specialist for Subaru, told TAPinto Camden.

While the city's cleanup is in its fifth year, this year marked the first time trees were given away during the kickoff event, Leiter also told TAPinto Camden.

Camden Mayor Victor Carstarphen, before helping clean up the park with the dozens of volunteers who showed up for the kickoff, noted that about 4,500 volunteers have participated in at least one of the city's annual cleanups through the years.

CAMDEN – The Daelight Foundation and Boys of Sustainable Strength Mentoring are positively changing and influencing children and teenagers throughout the city, thanks to Camden Education Fund Youth-Serving Organization grants.

For example, some of the \$40,000 grant the Daelight Foundation received went into the foundation's scholarship fund, according to Tracey Hall, the foundation's founder and executive director.

The rest of the grant helped purchase supplies and to train volunteers to enable more high school students to take a six-session National Council for Mental Wellbeing course titled "Mental Health First Aid," according to Hall.

Hall said in an interview that one in five students will experience a mental health condition such as anxiety, depression, eating disorders, post-traumatic stress disorder or schizophrenia before turning 18.

St. Joseph's Carpenter Society opens East Camden job skills center and community hub

As it continues to rebuild East Camden's housing stock, the St. Joseph's Carpenter Society is adding vocational and job readiness services — and sharing expertise it has gained over the last 40 years.

Student interns, aspiring construction workers, and neighborhood residents who want to learn how to improve their own houses are welcome at the nonprofit's new workforce training and community resource center at 29th and Federal Streets.

With \$1 million in public and private funding, a former warehouse that was empty for six years has become the centerpiece of the faith-based nonprofit's latest effort to bolster four East Camden neighborhoods.

“As we updated the master plan for East Camden in 2021, we saw how we were actually making a difference,” said Pilar Hogan, the society's executive director since 2004. “We had blocks that were intact, with no vacant houses. So we began to think about what else East Camden needed to become a true neighborhood of opportunity.”

Bishop of Camden Diocese Offers Suggestion for Those Needing Enlightenment in Wake of First Latin American Pontiff's Death

CAMDEN – Pope Francis, who died Monday at age 88, never set foot in Camden, but he still left an impression here.

Camden City Council President Angel Fuentes, on his Facebook page, called the first Latin American pontiff “a humble pope who boldly spoke to the most powerful people about the value of loving thy neighbors. He was not afraid to speak to the most influential CEOs, emphasizing the need to give back to the poor.”

Camden County Commissioner Director Louis Cappelli Jr., in a statement, called Pope Francis “a visionary (and a) person who did not abide by the rules set before him in order to create a more progressive and welcoming environment.”

Joseph Williams, the Bishop of the Diocese of Camden, presided over the Mass. He and all the clergy who assisted him were dressed in ivory vestments and blue stoles. Consistent with Camden's growing Latino population and Pope Francis's native language, some of the prayers, readings and songs were in Spanish.
